Breast Cancer Screening (BCS-E)		
<p>People with female sex assigned at birth, or female gender at any time in the member’s history, 50–74 years of age, who had at least one mammogram to screen for breast cancer in the past 27 months: 10/01/2023 to 12/31/2025</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bilateral mastectomy</li><li>• Unilateral mastectomy with bilateral modifier</li><li>• History of gender-affirming chest surgery (CPT 19318) with diagnosis of gender dysphoria</li></ul>	<p><b>PCP Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Document the date of the patient’s last mammogram</li><li>• Order mammograms as part of preventative care visits and have office staff assist in scheduling the appointment</li><li>• HEDIS-acceptable forms of mammography: diagnostic, film, digital, or digital tomosynthesis</li><li>• MRIs, ultrasounds, and biopsies <b>DO NOT</b> count toward HEDIS compliance.</li><li>• Explicitly document the member’s gender in the medical record</li><li>• Document and code exclusions found in the member’s history or on exam</li></ul>	<p><b>Key Screening Codes:</b> <u>CPT</u>: 77061-77063, 77065-77067</p> <p><b>Key Exclusion Codes:</b> <u>ICD10PCS</u>: 0HTV0ZZ <u>ICD10DX</u>: Z90.13</p>
Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS-E)		
<p>People with female sex assigned at birth, or female gender at any time in the member’s history, 21–64 years of age who were recommended for routine cervical cancer screening and were who were screened for cervical cancer using any of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cervical cytology performed within the last 3 years (ages 21-64)</li><li>• Cervical high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) testing within the last 5 years (ages 30-64)</li><li>• Cervical cytology high-risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) co-testing within the last 5 years (ages 30-64)</li></ul> <p><b>Exclusions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hysterectomy with no residual cervix, cervical agenesis, or acquired absence of cervix</li><li>• Male sex assigned at birth</li></ul>	<p><b>PCP Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Document date and result of patient’s last cervical screening</li><li>• Complete screening if service offered in PCP office or refer to OB/GYN for screening. Follow-up for completion of screening, if done elsewhere</li><li>• Lab results that explicitly state the sample was inadequate or “no cervical cells were present” <b>DO NOT</b> meet HEDIS criteria</li><li>• Explicitly document the member’s gender in the medical record</li><li>• Document and code exclusions found in the member’s history or on exam:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ “Complete,” “total,” or “radical” hysterectomy</li><li>○ “Vaginal hysterectomy”</li><li>○ “hysterectomy” + with no residual cervix</li></ul></li></ul>	<p><b>Key Screening Codes:</b> <b>Cervical Cytology Lab Test</b> (Age 21-64 every 3 years) <u>CPT</u>: 88141-88143, 88147- 88148, 88150, 88152-88153, 88164- 88167, 88174-88175 <u>HCPCS</u>: G0123, G0124, G0141, G0143- G0145, G0147, G0148, P3000, P3001 Q0091,</p> <p><b>hrHPV Test</b> (Age 30-64 every 5 years) <u>CPT</u>: 87624-87625 <u>HCPCS</u>: G0476</p> <p><b>Key Exclusion Codes:</b> <u>ICD10CM</u>: Z90.710</p>
Colorectal Cancer Screening (COL-E)		
<p>Members 45–75 years of age who had appropriate screening for colorectal cancer</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• History of colorectal cancer</li><li>• History of total colectomy</li></ul>	<p><b>PCP Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Document the date of the patient’s last colorectal cancer screening</li><li>• Order one of the following as part of a preventative care visit:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Annually: Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT) or guaiac (gFOBT)</li><li>○ Every 3 years: Stool FIT-DNA test (Cologuard)</li><li>○ Every 5 years: Flexible sigmoidoscopy</li><li>○ Every 5 years: CT colonography</li><li>○ Every 10 years: Colonoscopy</li></ul></li><li>• Document and code exclusions found in the member’s history or on exam</li></ul>	<p><b>Key Screening Codes:</b> <b>FIT/gFOBT – Annually</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>CPT</u>: 82270, 82274</li><li>• <u>HCPCS</u>: G0328</li></ul><b>sFIT-DNA Cologuard – every 3 years</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>CPT</u>: 81528</li><li>• <u>LOINC</u>: 77353-1, 77354-9</li></ul><b>Flex Sig – every 5 years</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>CPT</u>: 45330-45335, 45337-45338, 45340-45342, 45346-45347, 45349- 45350</li><li>• <u>HCPCS</u>: G0104</li></ul><b>CT Colonography – every 5 years</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>CPT</u>: 74621-74623</li></ul><b>Colonoscopy – every 10 years</b><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <u>CPT</u>: 44388-44392, 44394, 44401- 44408, 45378-45382, 45384-45386, 45388-45393,45398</li><li>• <u>HCPCS</u>: G0105 (high risk), G0121 (normal risk)</li></ul><p><b>Key Exclusion Codes:</b> <u>ICD10CM</u>: Z85.038, Z85.048, C18-C21 <u>CPT</u>: 44150-44153, 44155-44158, 44210, 44211</p></p>
Depression Screening and Follow-Up for Adolescents and Adults (DSF-E)		
<p>Members 12 years of age and older who were screened for clinical depression using a standardized tool and, if screened positive, received follow-up care</p>	<p><b>PCP Responsibilities:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Document the standardized tool used, date, and result of depression screening</li><li>• Incorporate the brief screening, such as PHQ-2, into your office’s check-in process</li><li>• Review results during physical exam, if positive results, rescreen with a full-length tool, such as PHQ-9, and document results</li><li>• Refer for additional treatment</li><li>• Consider medication therapy, if needed</li><li>• Incorporate depression screening tool LOINC codes into your EMR platform, such as:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ PHQ-2 55758-7 <i>positive finding</i> ≥ to 3</li><li>○ PHQ-9 44261-6 <i>positive finding</i> ≥ to 10</li></ul></li></ul>	<p><b>Key Screening Codes:</b> <u>CPT</u>: 96127 for brief emotional and behavioral assessments</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Utilization of the CPT code alone does not meet HEDIS numerator compliance without the use of the LOINC code, which indicates the tool used for screening and the total score</p>
